





All three practices scored similarly with an average of 83% saying they were either 'fairly satisfied' or 'very satisfied' with current opening hours.

DESIRED OPENING HOURS

- Majority prefer 6pm-8pm Monday Friday
- Those aged 55-64 preferred Saturday 10am-12pm the most
- Over 65s prefer 10am-12pm any day (Mon-Sat)







APPOINTMENT TYPE



- All 3 practices performed almost identically in terms of preference for appointment types offered
- 18-24 year olds had a 37% higher interest in Mental Health than other age groups (68%)
- 25-54 year olds showed more need for Screening e.g. cervical smears and women's/men's health checks
- Over 65s expressed more interest and a need for NHS Health Checks and Nurse clinics (e.g. wound dressing, injections)




